<b>Second Draw PPP Loans</b>	Nationally	PPP now allows certain eligible borrowers that previously received a PPP loan to apply for a Second Draw PPP Loan with the same general loan terms as their First Draw PPP Loan. <b>PPN Loan Forgiveness</b>	Nationally	A borrower can apply for forgiveness once all loan proceeds for which the borrower is requesting forgiveness have been used.
